- Laycan/Expected date of shipment
- Cargo, Specifications & Origin

2. Contact the exporter to coordinate physical inspection in the ports
3. Holds are inspected
4. Samples are taken throughout loading and laboratory testing/analysis is carried out in accredited labs
5. Weight of cargo is inspected during loading
6. Baltic Control® verifies consistency and accuracy of data collected during the verification process. Upon satisfactory result Inspection Certificates are prepared

This Certificate is accepted by the importers and banks who can release payment against letter of credit.
